## Overview

To improve the streetscape of Webster and Main Streets with a landmark that compliments the historic nature of Downtown and helps to further promote the sense of place NT has been cultivating for several years.

## Goals

1. To construct a landmark clock tower which will serve as a focal point of the Downtown district
2. Improve and expand an underutilized park by adding green space and improving amenities

## Specifications

### Clock

The clock tower itself could be constructed by Essence of Time, a large street clock manufacturer with facilities in North Tonawanda. An initial clock design and estimate for a 8' x8' clock on a 20' tall tower were provided and are included in the packet.

### Site Work

Significant improvements to the site would be necessary to the make this project a reality. Extending the curb line to the north and removing a lane currently used as parking along the side of the park would greatly enhance the green space. A full redesign of the landscaping and decorative fencing would complete the project
